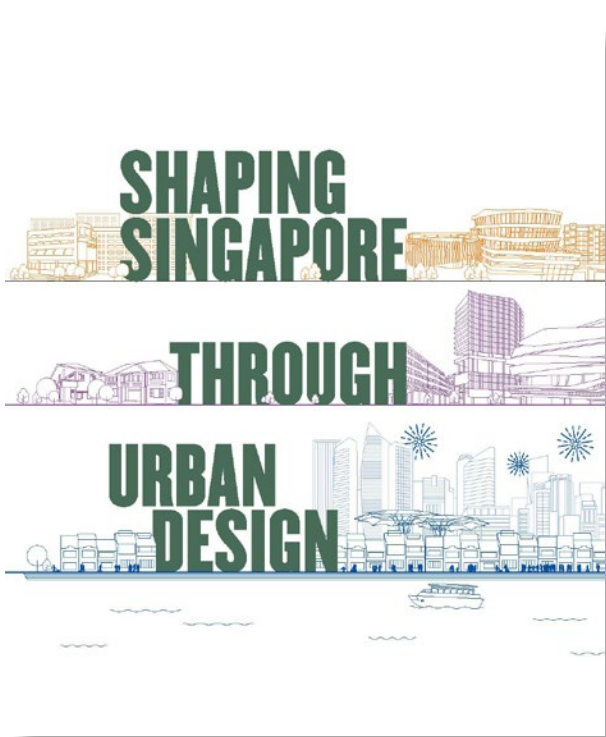


World Cities Summit Mayors Forum 2023

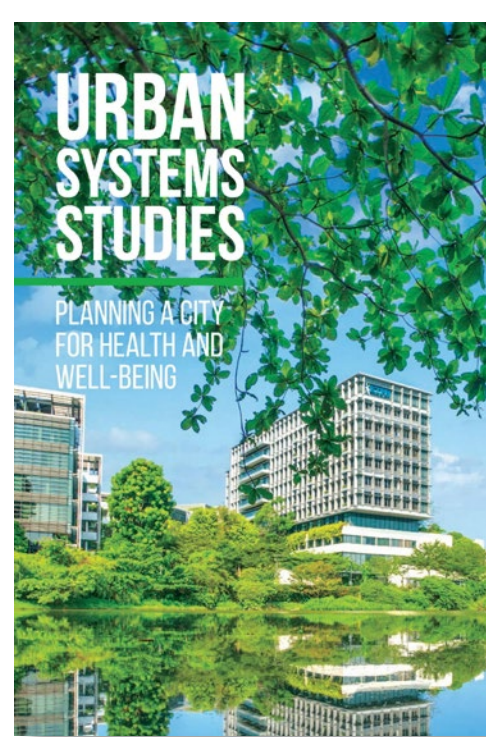


Shaping Singapore Through Urban Design
