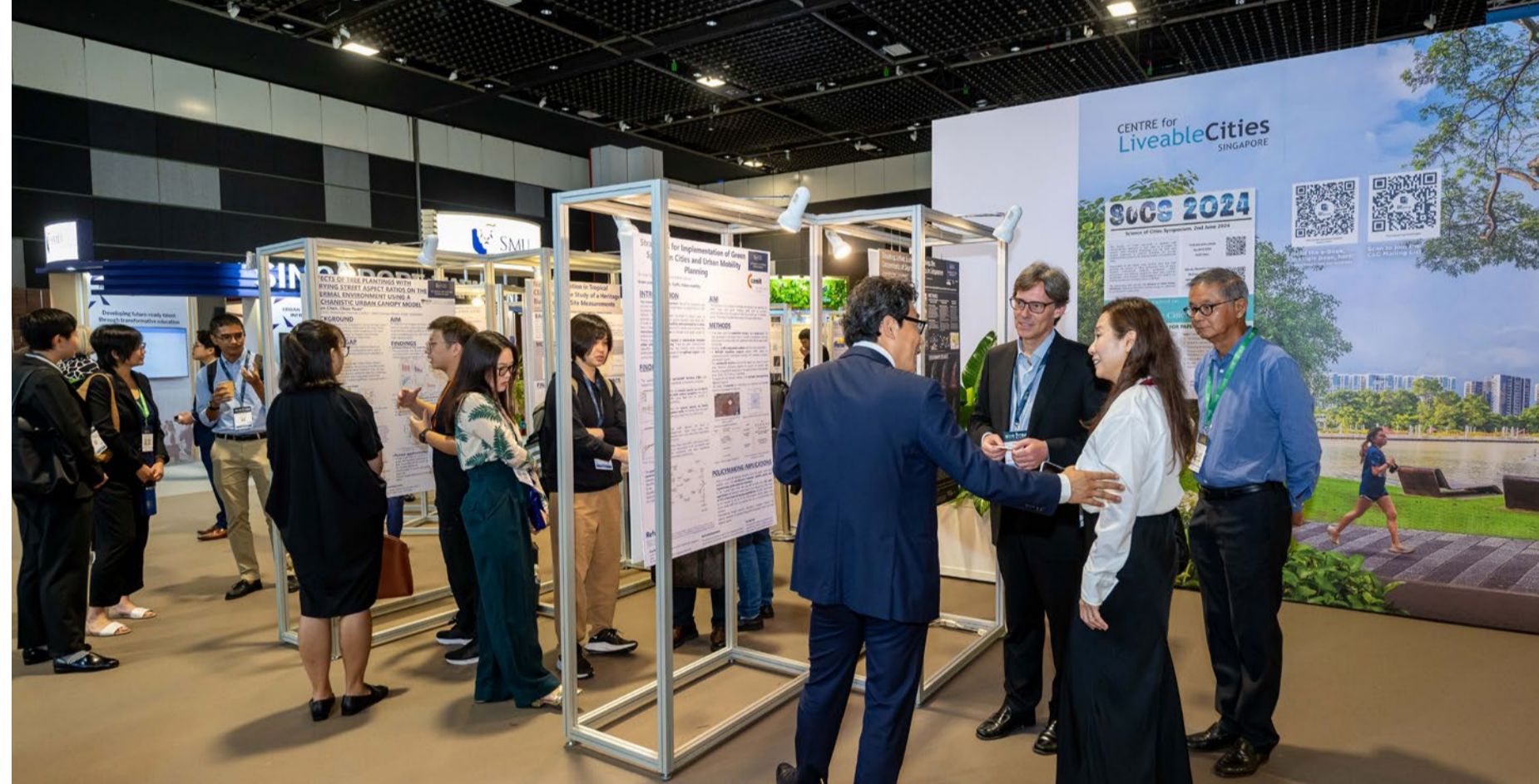
Liveability Framework : Part 2 – Achieving a Sustainable Environment
