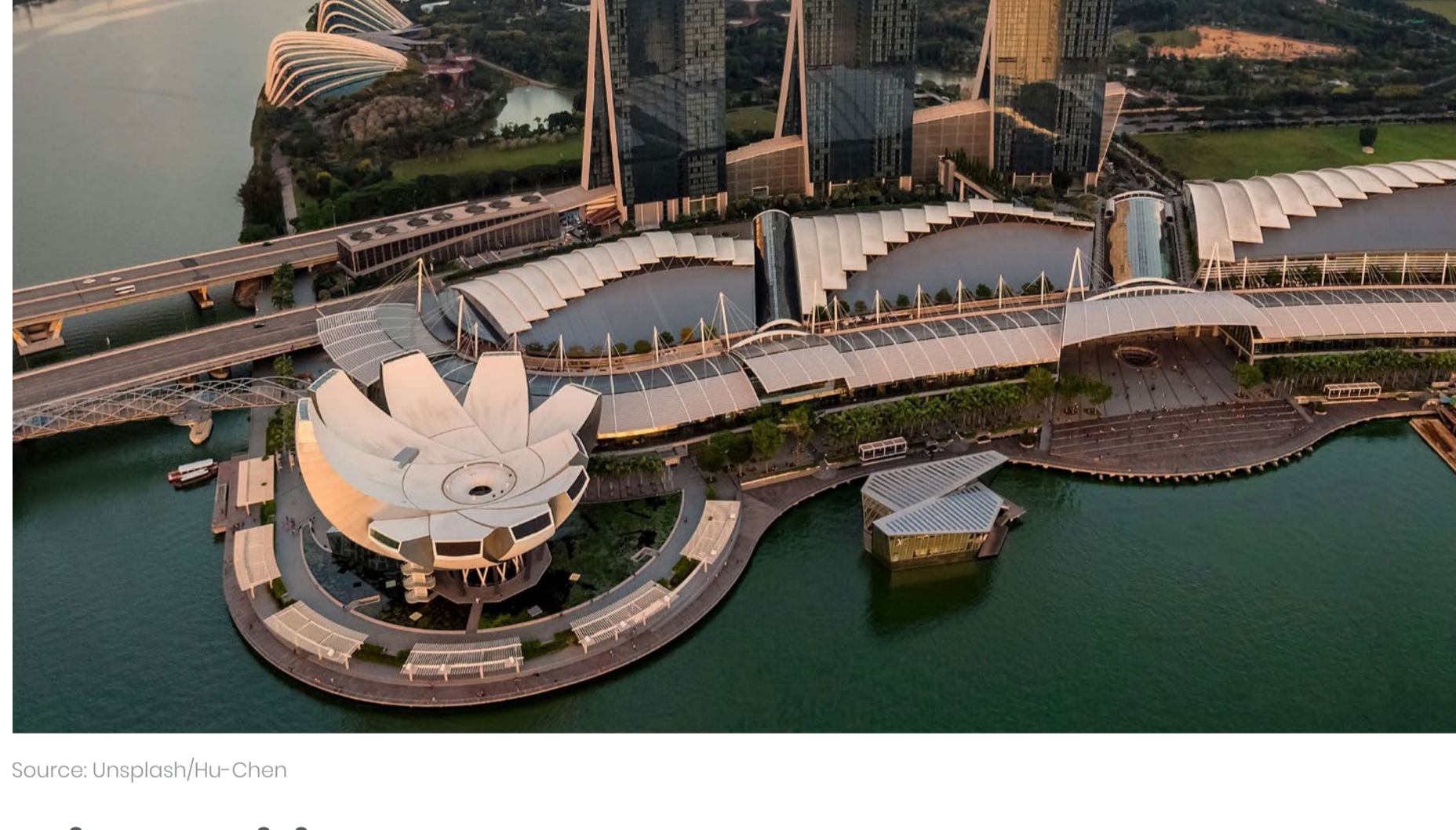

Integrated Master Planning and Development is one of the three systems underpinning the liveability framework. Explore the key principles guiding Singapore's urban development and planning process over the years here.

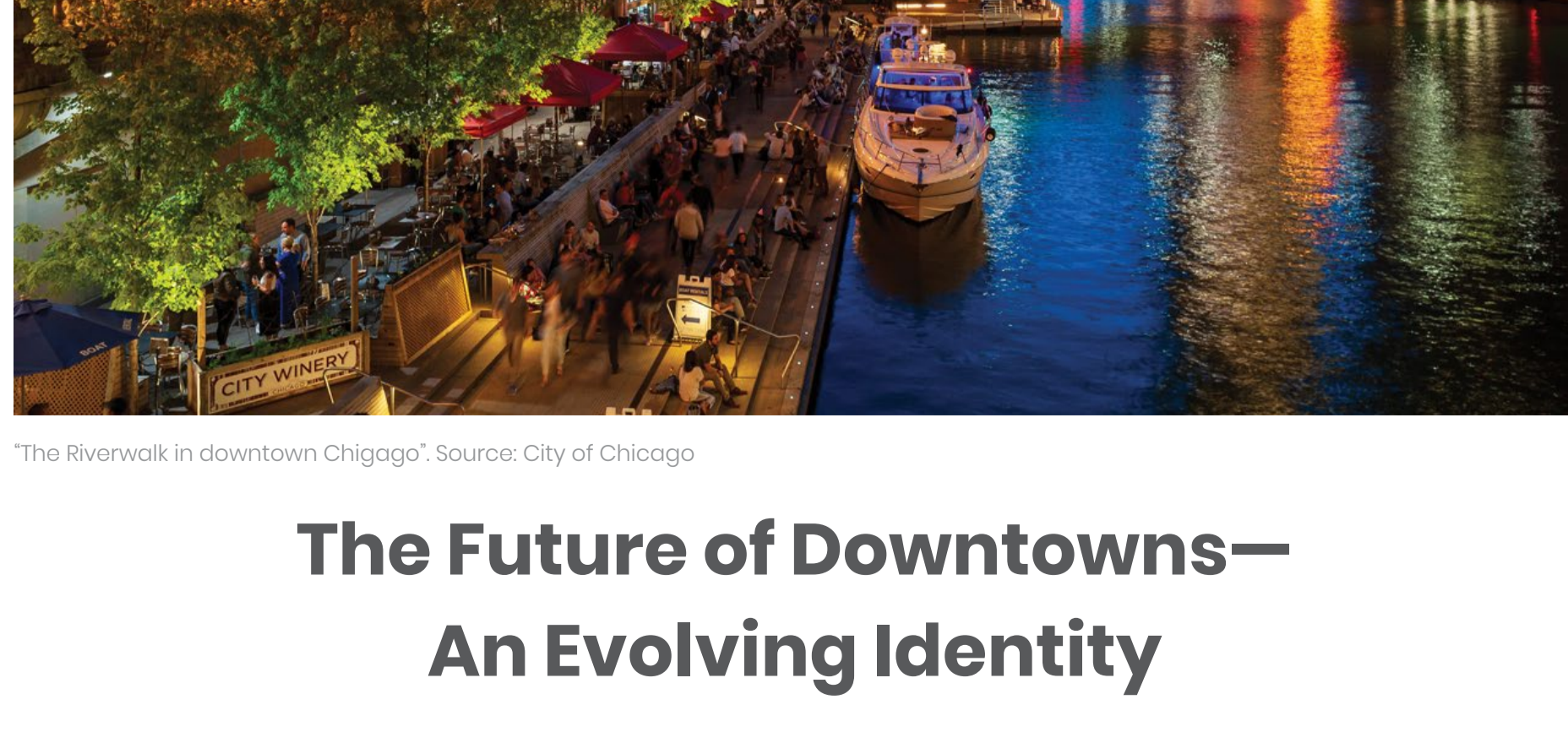
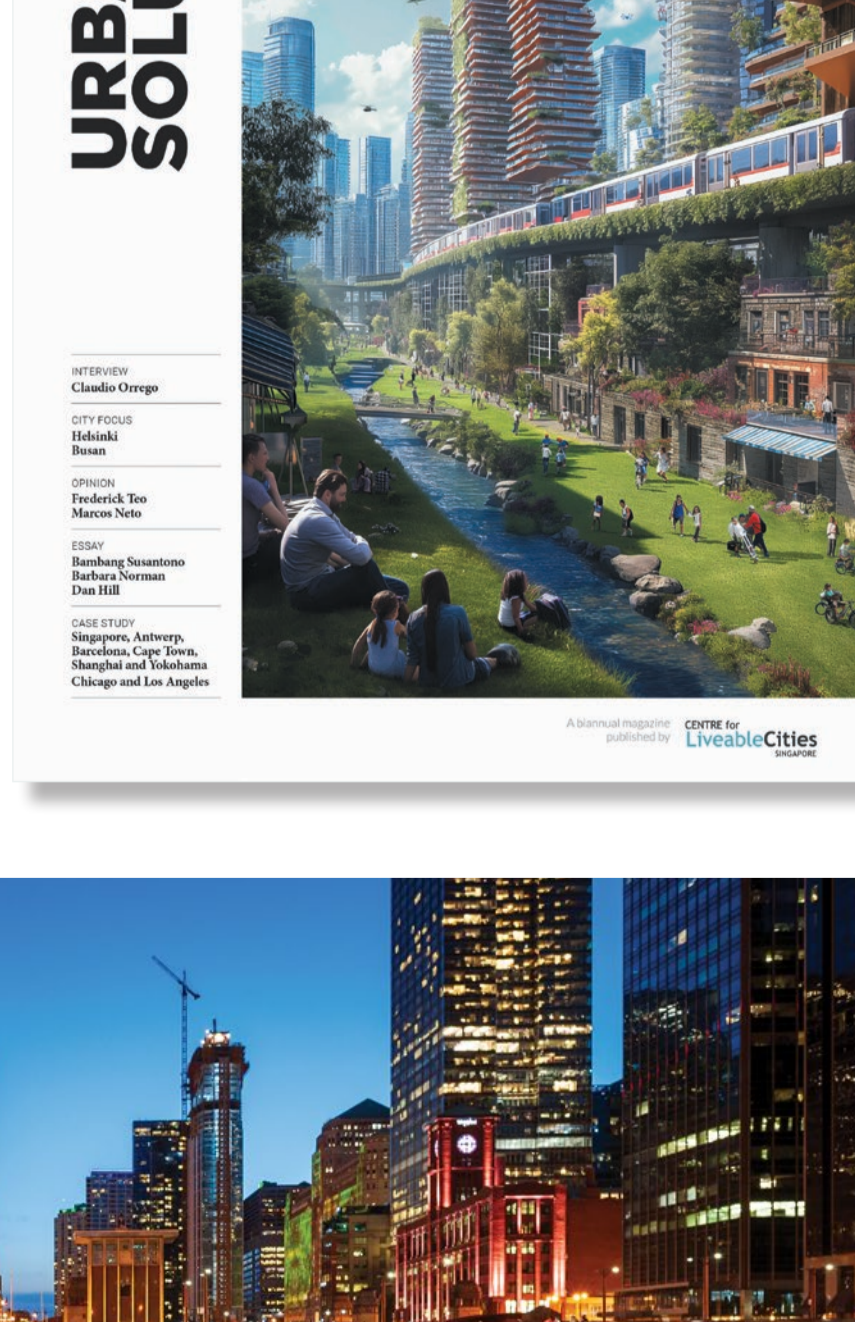
