**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN
THE CENTRE FOR LIVEABLE CITIES AND WRLDCTY PTE LTD
ON KNOWLEDGE EXCHANGE AND COLLABORATION TO CREATE LIVEABLE,
LOVABLE AND SUSTAINABLE CITIES**

12 February 2025 – Singapore’s Centre for Liveable Cities (CLC), and WRLDCTY Pte Ltd, a global forum for urban innovation, have signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) for knowledge exchange and international collaboration to advance the creation of endearing, distinctive and sustainable cities.

2 The MOU was inked by Hugh Lim, Executive Director, CLC, and representatives from WRLDCTY – Director Christopher Fair and Managing Director Anupam Yog, at a CLC Lecture on what makes cities lovable and liveable.

Scope of MOU

3 This MOU, a first between CLC and [WRLDCTY](#), aims to provide an overarching framework for knowledge exchange and collaboration across various platforms such as conferences and symposiums, joint research projects, studies and publications. Through the MOU, CLC and WRLDCTY also seek to leverage on each other’s networks and to build new connections globally.

4 This MOU enables both CLC and WRLDCTY to draw on the collective expertise and experience in curating and organising global conferences and knowledge-sharing events. Both parties will support and collaborate through participating in expert panel discussions, and programming complementary sessions or workshops at key events, such as CLC’s upcoming World Cities Summit in June 2026. WRLDCTY will be bringing their global WRLDCTY conference to Singapore for the first time, alongside the upcoming World Cities Summit, and work with CLC to expand and enrich conference offerings for all participants.

5 CLC and WRLDCTY will also be delving further into knowledge and insights, experience and new methods for the measurement and design of liveable and sustainable cities and regions. Both parties will explore avenues such as co-authoring knowledge products (e.g., blogs, articles, urban briefs, etc.) that translate existing research work into actionable steps for implementation.

6 “CLC and WRLDCTY believe that cities should be liveable, distinctly loveable and sustainable. Through this partnership, we aim to offer greater insights, inspire more innovative approaches and solutions, and leverage on each other’s networks to reach out to more city leaders and urban practitioners around the world. CLC looks forward to our collaboration, and especially to WRLDCTY sharing their knowledge and bringing their WRLDCTY conference alongside the World Cities Summit in 2026,” said Hugh Lim, Executive Director, CLC.

7 “CLC and Resonance have both been studying and sharing best practises in sustainable urban development and innovation for more than a decade. This collaboration is not only an opportunity to bring the best minds from both our organizations together on key research initiatives, but to amplify our outreach and knowledge sharing together with countries, cities and communities around the world,” said Christopher Fair, President and CEO of Resonance and Director, WRLDCTY.
